Students who wish to present a poster at the event must submit a faculty-reviewed abstract to the Undergraduate Research Program Director at undergraduateresearch@norwich.edu by April 10th.

DELIVER AN ORAL PRESENTATION!

We are looking for students to deliver **oral presentations** during the week of May 1st. If you wish to present your research to the Norwich University community in a 15-minute presentation, please submit an abstract. We will find a space and time for you to present your work.

All abstracts for posters and presentations must be reviewed by a faculty sponsor and emailed as a PDF to Amy Woodbury Tease, the Undergraduate Research Program Director, at undergraduateresearch@norwich.edu by **April 10th**. Please copy your faculty sponsor on the submission email.
