International Travel Grants

DESCRIPTION: To support international professional travel experiences
ELIGIBILITY: Tenure-track Faculty
GRANT SIZE: Up to \$2,000, independent or supplemental to other grants
APPLICATION: [FD Activity Expenses](#) Grant Application for conference related travel, or a [FD Research Expenses](#) Grant Application for active scholarship travel, via Department Chairs and Deans to the AVPR
DEADLINE: Rolling

New Faculty Startup Grants

DESCRIPTION: To acquire equipment or other resources in support of research or other scholarly endeavors
ELIGIBILITY: New Tenure-track Faculty
GRANT SIZE: Between \$2,000 and \$10,000 (Chase plus other funds)
APPLICATION: By negotiation with College Deans and AVPR at time of hire
DEADLINE: Prior to employment

The Apprentice Program Grants

DESCRIPTION: To support faculty for specific research projects and curriculum development initiatives, introducing students to professional life.
ELIGIBILITY: Tenure-track Faculty
GRANT SIZE: Up to \$1,500 per semester
APPLICATION: [Apprentice Grant Application](#), to FD Coordinator and URPD via facultydevelopment@norwich.edu & undergraduateresearch@norwich.edu
DEADLINE: For Fall - 1st Monday in April; for Spring - 1st Monday in November; for full Academic year – 1st Monday in April; for Summer – 1st Monday in February.

Faculty Scholarship Release-time Awards

DESCRIPTION: For work on a scholarly research project
ELIGIBILITY: Tenure-track Faculty (single release per year)
GRANT SIZE: 3 contact hour release time from teaching in a single semester
APPLICATION: [FD Dana Fellowship application](#) via Deans to the AVPR
DEADLINE: End of September for following Spring; February 15th for following Fall

Visiting Scholar Grants

DESCRIPTION: To bring renowned scholars to the university to stimulate the scholarly productivity of the faculty and to present some aspect of their work to the larger academic community at Norwich
ELIGIBILITY: Tenure-track Faculty
GRANT SIZE: Between \$1,000 and \$5,000
APPLICATION: [Chase Visiting Scholar Proposal](#) form, via Deans to AVPR
DEADLINE: Rolling
